To the Constables of the Town of Wrentham in the County of Norfolk;
Greetings:

You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn qualified voters of said Town of Wrentham to assemble at the King Philip Regional High School, 201 Franklin Street, Wrentham, MA 02093 at 7:00PM on Monday, May 12, 2025 then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1: Land Purchase of 2095 West Street


To see if the Town will appropriate \$1,900,000 by transfer from any available source of funds or by borrowing to pay the costs of acquiring a parcel of land for conservation purposes located at 2095 West Street, and shown on the Town of Wrentham Assessor's Map C-03-1-3, containing an area of 65 acres, more or less, including the payment of all costs incidental and related thereto; to determine whether this amount shall be raised by borrowing, including a borrowing utilizing G.L. c. 44B (also known as the Community Preservation Act) or any other enabling authority, or otherwise, and to further authorize the Select Board to execute any and all instruments as may be necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Article; or to take any other action relative thereto.

Article 2: Sweatt Park Lighting & Electrical Improvements


To see if the Town will appropriate the sum of \$350,000 from the Undesignated Fund Balance of the Community Preservation Fund, for the purpose of funding electrical and lighting improvements at Sweatt Park. Funds appropriated must be used by December 31, 2026 or will be returned to their source, and no longer be available for expenditure on this project; or take any other action relative thereto.


